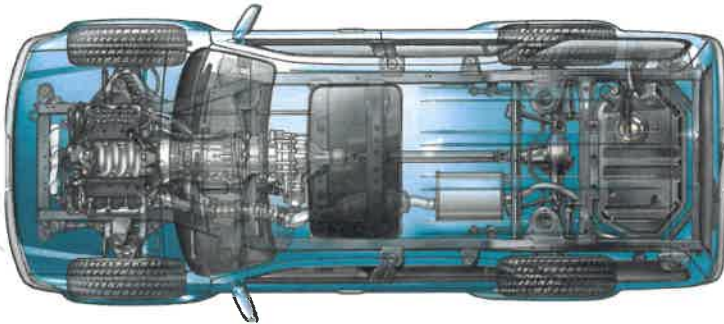


## IF IT'S NOT ON THE LIST, IT'S COVERED! (It even includes rental up to 6 days.)

Your Premier Plan covers practically all factory-installed mechanical and electrical operating parts. The few items not covered are typically those involved in scheduled services and normal wear and tear, such as\*:

- Regular maintenance services as recommended by the manufacturer
- Normal maintenance parts and services such as engine tune-ups, batteries, filters, fluids, A/C refrigerant, hoses and belts, wiper blades, brake pads, tires, wheels and balancing, exhaust system, catalytic converter and manual clutch components
- Window glass, head lamps, trim, moldings, upholstery, convertible tops, paint, sheet metal & flexible body parts, bumpers, door panels & handles and structural framework
- Aftermarket accessories or equipment not installed by the manufacturer
- Repairs to meet emissions standards
- Hybrid vehicle battery
